The organizing committee of the conference "Advances in Computational Biology - fostering collaboration among women scientists", which will be held in *La Pedrera* Barcelona, Spain, on November 28-29th 2019, would like to contact you regarding sponsorship opportunities.

The **confirmed Chairwomen** of the conference will be **: Alison Kennedy**, director of the *STFC Hartree Centre*, **Janet Kelso**, group leader of the Minerva Research Group for Bioinformatics at the *Max Planck Institute for Evolutionary Anthropology*, and **Nuria Lopez-Bigas**, group leader of the Biomedical Genomics Research Group at the *Institute for Research in Biomedicine Barcelona* (IRB Barcelona).

We are working on a scientific programme that will include poster and oral presentations, as well as keynote talks from top women scientists in the computational biology field. The conference will foster collaborations between women scientists and provide an excellent frame for scientists worldwide to present their work and share ideas about their research.

Furthermore, the participants will have the opportunity to interact personally with women leaders in the fields of IT, academic research and politics that support the conference (<u>Carmen Vela Olmo</u>, <u>Angeles Delgado</u>, <u>Gemma Fargas Ribas</u>, <u>Guayente Sanmartin</u>). There will also be a panel discussion proposed by the Association for Computing Machinery -Women's Europe (ACM-WE) and jointly organised with RSG-Spain.
